Pacific Sea Salt Snacks Recalled for Milk Allergens

(JUNEAU, AK) – Somersault Snack Co., LLC has issued a recall for 6-ounce packages of Pacific Sea Salt flavored Somersault snacks that inadvertently contain amounts of Santa Fe Salsa flavored snacks. The Santa Fe flavored product contains milk as an ingredient. Milk is not listed on the Pacific Sea Salt package as an ingredient or an allergen.

People who have an allergy or severe sensitivity to milk run the risk of serious or life-threatening allergic reaction if they consume this product.

The affected product is sold in 6-ounce containers with a UPC of 8-98403-00201-7, and marked with the Sell By Date: MAR1113 G6 located on the back of the package, in the middle above the sunflower graphics.

Alaska DEC has confirmed distribution of this product in Alaska. To date, there have been no reported illnesses associated with this product.

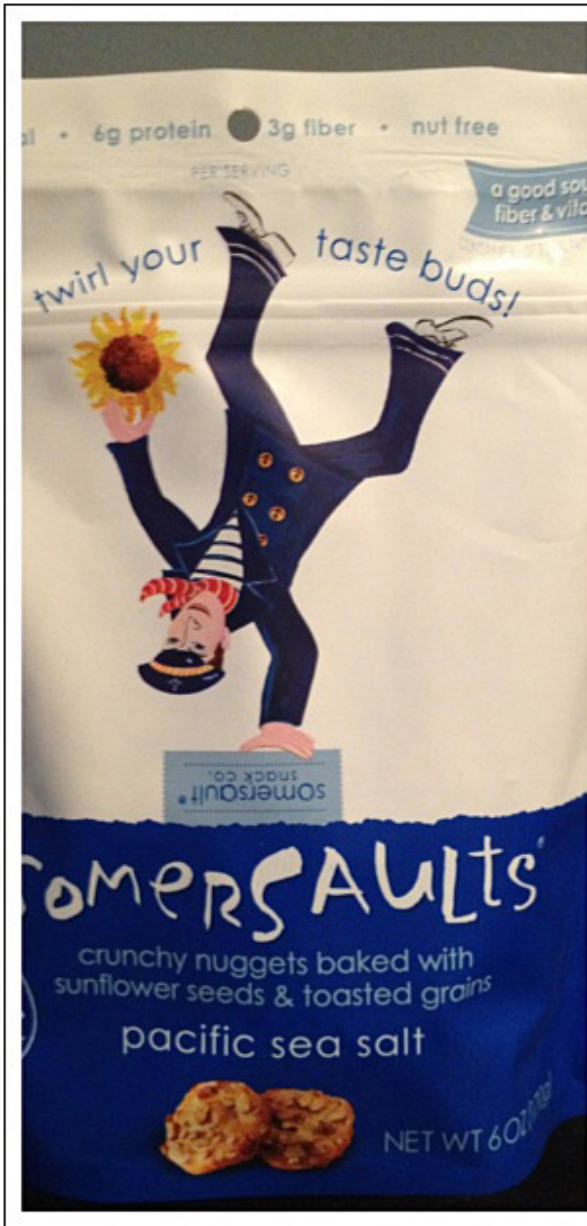
