

**PUBLIC NOTICE

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) proposes to renew an Air Quality Control Operating Permit to the BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc., Central Gas Facility, under Alaska Statutes 46.14 and regulation 18 AAC 50.

Location: West Dock Road, north of Deadhorse, AK in Greater Prudhoe Bay Unit

Activity: Gas-fired turbines, gas-fired heaters, liquid fuel-fired equipment, flares and a gas processing facility

Application: BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc. applied for a renewal for the Central Gas Facility Title V operating permit on March 3, 2008.

Emissions: The potential annual emissions of regulated air pollutants at the source will not exceed: 305 tons of Particulate Matter, 10,968 tons of Nitrogen Oxides, 276 tons of Sulfur Dioxide, 1,787 tons of Carbon Monoxide, and 90 tons of Volatile Organic Compounds. Total emissions are 13,426 tons per year.

ADEC Preliminary Review: Based on review of the application, ADEC drafted a preliminary permit decision for the BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc., Central Gas Facility.

Available Information: Copies of ADEC's draft Operating Permit and Statement of Basis are available at ADEC's offices at 619 East Ship Creek Avenue, Anchorage, AK 99501-2617, (907) 269-7577.

Opportunity for Public Participation: Notice is also given that any interested person may present written statements relevant to the draft documents within 30 days after the first publication date. Any person may request a public hearing and that hearing will be held if ADEC finds that good cause exists. ADEC will consider all comments received and make any changes ADEC finds beneficial or necessary to assure compliance with 18 AAC 50 or State Law. ADEC will issue a final decision to issue or deny the permit after the close of the public comment period. Written comments will be included in the record if received before 5:00 p.m. Monday September 30, 2013. ADEC complies with Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.
