BP EXPLORATION (ALASKA), INC., CENTRAL COMPRESSOR PLANT

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) proposes to renew an Air Quality Control Operating Permit to the BP Exploration (Alaska), Inc., Central Compressor Plant, under Alaska Statutes 46.14 and regulation 18 AAC 50.

Location: West Dock Road north of Deadhorse, AK in the Greater Prudhoe Bay Unit

Activity: The stationary source consists of the following emissions units: gas turbines, gas-fired heaters, liquid fuel-fired equipment, flares and storage tanks.

The BP Exploration (Alaska), Inc., Central Compressor Plant applied for a Title V permit renewal on March 3, 2008.

Emissions: The potential annual emissions of regulated air pollutants at the source will not exceed: 208 tons of Particulate Matter, 14,238 tons of Nitrogen Oxides, 502 tons of Sulfur Dioxide, 1,631 tons of Carbon Monoxide, and 84.5 tons of Volatile Organic Compounds. The total emissions are 16,663 tons per year. The total potential annual Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) emissions, which are almost all VOCs, are 53.8 tons per year. The total potential annual GHG CO₂e emissions are 3,154,851 tons per year.

ADEC Preliminary Review: Based on review of the application, ADEC drafted a preliminary permit decision for BP Exploration (Alaska), Inc., Central Compressor Plant.

The administrative record for this permit is available for review at ADEC's Anchorage and Juneau offices during normal business hours, Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

Opportunity for Public Participation: Notice is also given that any interested person may present written statements relevant to the draft documents within 30 days after the first publication date. Any person may request a public hearing and that hearing will be held if ADEC finds that good cause exists. ADEC will consider all comments received and make any changes ADEC finds beneficial or necessary to assure compliance with 18 AAC 50 or State Law. ADEC will issue a final decision to issue or deny the permit after the close of the public comment period. Written comments will be included in the record if received before 5:00 p.m. October 14, 2013. ADEC complies with Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.
