

**PUBLIC NOTICE

DUTCH HARBOR POWER PLANT**

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) proposes to issue Air Quality Control Minor Permit AQ0215MSS05 to the City of Unalaska for the Dutch Harbor Power Plant. Additionally, ADEC proposes to issue a significant revision to Operating Permit AQ0215TVP04 using the integrated review procedures of 18 AAC 50.326(c)(1).

Applicant: City of Unalaska, PO Box 610, Unalaska, AK 99685

Location: 1732 East Point Road, Dutch Harbor, AK 99685

Activity: City of Unalaska's application is classified under 18 AAC 50.508(5) to establish owner requested limits, 18 AAC 50.502(c)(2)(B) for the installation of a new emission unit with heat input exceeding 10 MMBtu/hr in a sulfur dioxide special protection area, and 18 AAC 50.508(6) for revising Title I conditions. Only conditions being revised in response to the application and as described in the technical analysis report and statement of basis are open to public comment.

Emissions: Potential emissions at the stationary source are 1,258.6 tpy for NO_x, 135.5 tpy for CO, 30.5 tpy for PM-10/PM-2.5, 4.6 tpy for SO₂ and 50.3 tpy for VOC.

ADEC Preliminary Review: Based on review of the application, ADEC has drafted preliminary minor permit and draft operating permit decisions under AS 46.14 and 18 AAC 50.

Opportunity for Public Participation: Any interested person may present written statements relevant to the draft documents within 30 days after the first publication date. ADEC will consider all comments received and make any changes ADEC finds beneficial or necessary to assure compliance with 18 AAC 50 or state law. ADEC will issue a final decision to issue or deny the permits after the close of the public comment period. Any person may request a public hearing and that hearing will be held if ADEC finds that good cause exists.
