Re: Removal of treatment and sampling requirement of landspread soil

## Dear Chris:

Thank you for meeting with Will, Erik and I last week and showing us the location of the contaminated soil that has been landspread in a large preserve managed by the Alaska Department of Fish and Game. We saw no obvious indications of remaining contamination issues. Since the soil is located in an area with no residences, the institutional control requirements of treatment and sampling have been removed.

ADEC approval is required for off-site soil disposal in accordance with 18 AAC 78.600 and should be noted that movement or use of potentially contaminated soil in a manner that results in a violation of 18 AAC 70 water quality standards is unlawful.

This determination is in accordance with 18 AAC 78.276(f) and does not preclude ADEC from requiring additional assessment and/or cleanup action if future information indicates that this site may pose an unacceptable risk to human health or the environment.
