Dear Ms. Kenshalo:

On October 26, 2012, the Kenai Area Office of the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) received your <u>Closure of CPAI Beluga River Unit Sites</u> letter, dated October 26, 2012. This letter addresses one of the sites addressed in the letter, the Beluga River Field.

The Beluga River Field project/site was created in ADEC records in 1990 to document the management of a 4,000 cubic yard stockpile of petroleum contaminated soils that were stored at the Beluga River airstrip for beneficial reuse as runway fill. ConocoPhillips has since provided confirmation that the stockpile no longer remains at the airstrip. Based on the information within our administrative file, we are issuing this Cleanup Complete Determination for the Beluga River Field site, and the ADEC Contaminated Sites database will be updated to reflect the change in site status as 'Cleanup Complete'.

This ADEC Decision is in accordance with 18 AAC 75.380(d), and does not preclude ADEC from requiring additional assessment and/or cleanup action(s) if future information indicates that this site may pose an unacceptable risk to human health, safety, welfare, and the environment.

## Appeal

Any person who disagrees with this decision may request an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 18 AAC 15.195 -18 AAC 15.340 or an informal review by the Division Director in accordance with 18 AAC 15.185. Informal review requests must be delivered to the Division Director, 410

Willoughby Avenue, Suite 303, Juneau, Alaska 99801, within 15 days after receiving the department's decision reviewable under this section. Adjudicatory hearing requests must be delivered to the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation, 410 Willoughby Avenue, Suite 303, Juneau, Alaska 99801, within 30 days after the date of issuance of this letter, or within 30 days after the department issues a final decision under 18 AAC 15.185. If a hearing is not requested within 30 days, the right to appeal is waived.
