The department received your sampling results from the latest stockpile sampling on October 26. Final sampling results for the two individual stockpile samples are tabulated below:

Contaminated soils resulted from the excavation of small-scale Diesel and Residual Range Organic (DRO, RRO) spills at the former Snow Removal Equipment Building. Excavation resulted in the stockpiling of approximately 30 cubic yards of soil for biocell treatment.

Sampled soils meet the approved Method One, Table A1 cleanup levels, including the most stringent standards for Benzene Toluene Ethylbenzene and Xylenes (BTEX) under Table B1. These soils qualify for unrestricted soil disposal requirements. All soils meeting these levels may now be disposed of at any non-environmentally sensitive location without department review and approval.
