Ms. Nixon:

On November 19, 2021, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, Contaminated Sites Program (ADEC), received the <u>2021 Groundwater Monitoring Program Report</u>, for Cannery Loop Unit Pad #3 dated November 2021. This document was prepared by Brice Environmental. The report is approved. We have the following comments.

MW-5 (offsite) DRO concentrations are elevated but below cleanup levels. Concentrations in MW-5 are increasing, indicating that contaminates are migrating offsite. Based on the increasing concentrations in MW-5, sampling frequency should increase from once every four years to biennially.

The report recommends replacing PZ-1 and PZ-2 if they remain dry. These well locations can be supplemented with additional wells, but not removed, as they are in the proper location to monitor site impacts when groundwater is present.
