Hello Mr. Sadler and Mr. Cook,

I wanted to let you know that ADEC has requested Alyeska Pipeline Service Company to do some additional groundwater and soil vapor investigations in portions of the contaminated groundwater plume that extends from the former Bentley tax Lot 201. As a result, we re-activated the site in our Contaminated Sites Database, but this action does not affect the Record of Decision (ROD) agreement that was established in 2006. There are no changes in cleanup levels, cleanup remedy, or soil management requirements with the former Tax Lot. It is simply a mechanism for us to engage the Responsible Party for some additional evaluation and assessment of risks associated with contaminated groundwater. I do not anticipate that you need to do anything, but I did want to let you know of this action, and that the agreement still remains in place. You may also get contacted by Alyeska at some point for permission to collect some soil gas or groundwater samples from your property.
