Re: Tesoro Alaska Refinery, ADEC Hazard ID# 312 Swamp Surface Water and Sediment Sampling Work Plan DEC Comments and Plan Approval

Ms. Plate:

On November 16, 2023, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, Contaminated Sites Program (ADEC), received the Swamp Surface Water and Sediment Sampling Work Plan. The work plan was prepared by Trihydro. ADEC has the following comments.

ADEC has reviewed the historical wetland sampling data for benzene distribution and noted the decline in benzene concentrations over time. The work plan proposes a one-time sampling event for total aromatic hydrocarbons (TAH) and total aqueous hydrocarbons (TAqH) in sediment and surface water. DEC will require sampling surface water and sediment quarterly, as the regulatory levels are stringent, and concentrations may vary significantly over the seasons with fluctuating water levels.

We see value in collecting water samples thru the ice if possible. Ultimately, the compliance point for surface water quality will be shallow monitoring wells at the upgradient perimeter of the wetland. Marathon will be responsible in demonstrating if current monitoring wells are representative of groundwater entering the wetlands, or if new monitoring wells needed.
