ADEC Comments - Requirement for Work Plan

Mr. Kiernan,

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation Contaminated Sites Program (ADEC), would like to thank you for submitting the Per and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances Sampling Results Summary Letter. This report was prepared by Arcadis and was received in our office on November 4, 2021.

On April 13, 2022, ADEC requested a work plan with the following comments:

Due to the detection of polyfluoroalkyl substances in groundwater, ADEC is requiring the assessment of shallow soils in the former fire training area. The assessment should include an evaluation of the use of the fire training area, any previous remediation work that may have been conducted in the area, and an evaluation of the soil sufficient to determine if environmental risks might be associated with the site.

Assessment should also be conducted in areas where polyfluoroalkyl substances were stored or used to fight facility fires.
