Division issued an APDES permit on April 10, 2017 to GVEA for wastewater discharges from the Healy Power Plant. Two days after the permit was issued, the EPA announced reconsideration of a rulemaking standard that appears in the ADEC permit. GVEA has submitted a request for adjudicatory hearing, a request for stay of the permit and a concurrent request for alternative dispute resolution in lieu of the adjudicatory hearing to revise the permit pending EPA's final decision.
