Dear Mr. Woodruff:

This letter is in regards to the upcoming expiration of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) general permit for seafood processors (AK-G52-8000) operating shore-based facilities in Kodiak, Alaska. The Kodiak general permit expires on April 30, 2003.

ADEC renews the 401 certification for the Kodiak seafood general permit with this letter. This certification authorizes continued operation under the existing NPDES general permit with no changes to the permit requirements. This renewal of the 401 Certification does not constitute EPA's reauthorization of the federal NPDES seafood general permit that expires April 30, 2003. This renewal expires five years from today or upon state certification of a new Kodiak seafood general permit, whichever is sooner.
