Subject: Title V Operating Permit Standard Application Package

Dear «Title» «Last»:

The Department recently developed a draft Title V Operating Permit Standard Application Package (application package) and plans to use a two step process to incorporate this change in our permitting process.

First, the Department will seek informal comments and suggestions on the application package. Informal comments will be accepted from July 30 thru September 30, 2010. You may comment on the application package, including the potential costs to private persons of complying with the new application process, by submitting written comments to ADEC, Air Quality Division, Title V Operating Permit Program (Debra S. Dalcher), 619 E. Ship Creek, Ste. 249, Anchorage, AK 99501. The comments must be received no later than 5pm on September 30, 2010.

As part of this informal review period, permit staff plan to hold a workshop on the application package in Anchorage on September 1, 2010 and you are invited to attend. The workshop will be held at the Alaska State Library, 344 W 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue #125, Anchorage, AK 99501-2338 from 1:30 – 3:00 pm. After staff consideration of all comments and suggestions received during the above 60 day period, the second phase of this process will begin. This phase will include a formal rulemaking to adopt the application package by reference. We anticipate this formal public notice period to occur in January 2011.

Once adopted into regulation, the Department intends to make use of the application package a requirement for new and renewal operating permits as allowed under AS 46.14.140(a)(1). The use of the application package will standardize the initial/renewal operating permit process.
