RE: Port Moller – NFRAP and Institutional Controls Established

Dear Mr. Mattson,


This letter documents that the State of Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has identified the Port Moller Radio Relay site as “No Further Remedial Action Required” in our contaminated sites database along with a notation that institutional controls have been established.

Between February and April 1999, the DEC, the Air Force and the Corps of Engineers signed the Site Closure Decision Document for the Port Moller Radio Relay Site. The site investigation and cleanup work were conducted in coordination between the US Army Corps of Engineers (under the formerly used defense sites (FUDS) program), the 611 CES Air Force and the DEC. The former military buildings, antennas and other debris were landfilled on-site, fuel tanks were removed and disposed of properly and petroleum contaminated soil was excavated, thermally treated and used as fill on-site. The site closure decision document notes that the Air Force agreed to work with the DEC on developing institutional controls documenting the location of landfills and the area where subsurface petroleum contamination remains from a former outfall line.

On August 17, 2001 Moria Dennis with the Air Force forwarded a copy of documents recorded in Book #53, pages 477 through 509 in the Aleutian Islands Recording District. The recorded information includes a site and vicinity map, survey drawings showing the two landfills and the outfall area, and a copy of the Site Close-Out Report Port Moller. I had replied to Moria via email on August 17, 2001 that the recorded information met the institutional control requirements outlined in the decision document, but had not formally acknowledged this via a letter until now.
