- Background – The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC), Air Quality Division issued an Air Quality Control Minor Permit to TDX Power for two power plants located on the North Slope. The Air Quality Division's permit treats the North and South Plants as a single stationary source. TDX Power has requested an adjudicatory hearing on this decision.
