Parkers Farm Expands Recall To Include All Products

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration has announced that Parkers Farm Inc. has expanded its voluntary recall of several foods to include its complete line of products. They have the potential to be contaminated with *Listeria monocytogenes*, an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infection in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems
