

State of Alaska Import Requirements (February 2012)

SHEEP

All Domestic Sheep except those for immediate slaughter, must be accompanied by an official health certificate containing:

1. Negative Bluetounge test if the animal is over 3 months of age from a USDA approved laboratory within 30 days of importation.
2. Permit Number:
This number is issued by our office. To obtain a permit, give us a call. We will need names, physical addresses & telephone numbers for the issuing vet, origin owner, destination owner (if origin & destination owner is the same, we still need both addresses)
3. Health Certificate with permit number & below Statements 1&2
 - **USDA does not allow Sheep coming from Canada into Alaska at this time.**

Statements required on the health certificate

1. Scabies Free Area

The animals on this health certificate originates from a state/federal certified scabies free area, or the animal has been dipped under the supervision of an accredited veterinarian, in a solution approved by the USDA within 14 days of importation.

2. Statement that the animal originates from a flock not under state or federal restriction.
