Instructions

Water systems covered by 18 AAC 80.055 are required to complete a thorough review and update of either their Emergency Response Plan or Priority Measures Plan (as appropriate) biennially. Two years following the submittal of the "Emergency Preparedness Compliance Checklist," water systems must submit this form to certify that the associated plan has been updated.
