Indian Valley Meats of Indian, Alaska is recalling Hickory Smoked King Salmon sold exclusively out of our Gift Shop in Indian Alaska. The product has the potential to be contaminated with *Listeria Monocytogenes*, an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Although healthy individuals may suffer only short-term symptoms such as high fever, severe headache, stiffness, nausea, abdominal pain and diarrhea, *Listeria* infection can cause miscarriages and stillbirths among pregnant women.”

The product is labeled with a blue label stating Hickory Smoked Salmon and a white price label that says Smoked King Salmon; there is also a date label on the package that states July 21<sup>st</sup>, 2016, it is in vacuum packed packaging and the lot number is C002-16.

There have been no confirmed cases of illness from processing in July to date. The recall is a result of DEC testing that was conducted on this product in December of 2016. We would like to recall all of this product and consumers may have a full refund for this product. No other products sold are subject to this recall.
