SUBJECT: Dive Vessel Permit

Dear Operator:

Your application for a Geoduck Dive Vessel Permit has been reviewed and approved for 2019. Attached is a copy of your Permit. The Permit must be posted at a conspicuous place on your vessel and/or made available upon request during an inspection.

Your permit has been issued based on the boat drawings on file. If you plan any structural changes to the boat, please submit the proposed plans for review and approval. Review and approval of additions or changes must occur prior to operation or construction.

All shellfish harvested for human consumption must be protected from contamination or deterioration once harvested and properly tagged. All totes must have lids. Live animals including dogs are not allowed on harvest vessels. Dead animal carcasses are not allowed on harvest vessels.

If the product is stored in water, the water must be from the approved growing area. Water from outside the growing area cannot be pumped onto the product in transit.

Sewage must not be discharged while in the approved harvest area, and shall be contained in an approved holding tank to be disposed of at an approved dockside pump out station.
