INCIDENT LOCATION: Port William, Southern end of Shuyak Island, approximately 50 miles NNW of the city of

Kodiak

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: The incident occurred at approximately 8:00 a.m. on February 26, 2018.

**HOW/WHEN SPILL WAS DISCOVERED AND REPORTED:** The spill was reported to the National Response Center at approximately 4:00 p.m. on February 26, 2018.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: Up to 3,000 gallons of Fuel Oil No. 6 (Bunker C)

**CAUSE OF SPILL:** Wind gusts exceeding 80 mph pushed a building with the fuel bladder off a dock, causing the bladder to rupture and release its contents.

**SOURCE CONTROL:** The entire contents of the bladder are suspected to have been released. Alaska Chadux will deploy swift water boom across the bay's entrance and retrieve the bladder with any remaining contents upon arrival.

**RESPONSE ACTION:** The United States Coast Guard has accessed the Oil Spill Liability Trust fund and has contracted with Alaska Chadux, LLC for cleanup operations. Alaska Chadux deployed 10 personnel to Kodiak. They are currently loading response vessels and mobilizing to the spill site.

**RESOURCES AT RISK OR AFFECTED**: The surrounding area supports northern sea otters and Steller sea lions, both are ESA listed populations and may occur throughout the area. Additionally, the area is designated as critical habitat for both species. Eagles, waterfowl, and seabirds are likely present. Pacific halibut, pacific cod, walleye pollock, and pacific herring are present in surrounding waters.

**FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:** ADEC is working within the Unified Command structure to assess the extent of impacts and mitigate spill impacts. Response measures will be refined when initial reconnaissance reports are received.

**WEATHER:** 33F, WNW wind 20 kts becoming NW 30 kts in the evening. Seas 6-8 ft.
