

Deploy free-oil recovery strike teams upwind and up current of Orzinski Bay. Use aerial surveillance to locate incoming slicks.	Deploy multiple free-oil recovery strike teams as required to maximize interception of oil before it impacts sensitive areas.	Vessel platform.	Via marine waters Chart 16553-1	Same as AEA-03-02	Vessel master should have local knowledge. Use extreme caution, shoal waters with numerous reefs and rocks.
