Colville, Dalton Hwy MP 219.4 Truck Rollover

TIME/DATE OF DISTRIBUTION: 3:30 p.m. February 13, 2019

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Colville Transport, LLC. (Colville)

INCIDENT LOCATION: The incident occurred at MP 219.4 Dalton Highway, approximately 44.4 miles North of Cold Foot: 67.153067N, -149.8271167W.

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: The incident occurred at 2:43 PM on February 12, 2019

HOW/WHEN SPILL WAS DISCOVERED AND REPORTED: Colville reported the spill to ADEC at 3:06 PM on February 12, 2019.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: The spilled product is Ultra-Low Sulfur Diesel (ULSD). The tractor trailer was transporting 9,830 gallons of ULSD. The amount of spilled ULSD is unknown.

CAUSE OF SPILL: The truck departed the Dalton Highway, traveling approximately 70ft down an embankment. The cause is unknown at this time.

SOURCE CONTROL: The remaining fuel in the tractor trailer was lightered between 10:00 – 11:00 PM on February 12, 2019 and placed into an empty Colville tractor trailer. At 6:50 AM on February 13, 2019 the truck was pulled out of the embankment. At 8:00 AM, the trailer was pulled out of the embankment.

RESPONSE ACTION: Carlile Transportation Systems and Alaska West Express arrived onsite and provided personnel and resources for the initial response. The truck was lightered into an empty Colville truck, which is heading to Deadhorse for the fuel to be metered. After ADEC received the report, an ADEC responder at Pump Station 4 was dispatched to the incident site. Currently, Colville, Bureau of Land Management (BLM), and ADEC are delineating the site.

RESOURCES AT RISK OR AFFECTED: The Dietrich River is approximately 500 ft away from the incident. The Dietrich River flows South into the Middle Fork Koyukuk River.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: ADEC will continue to monitor the response actions and review plans being developed to clean up contaminated material at the site.

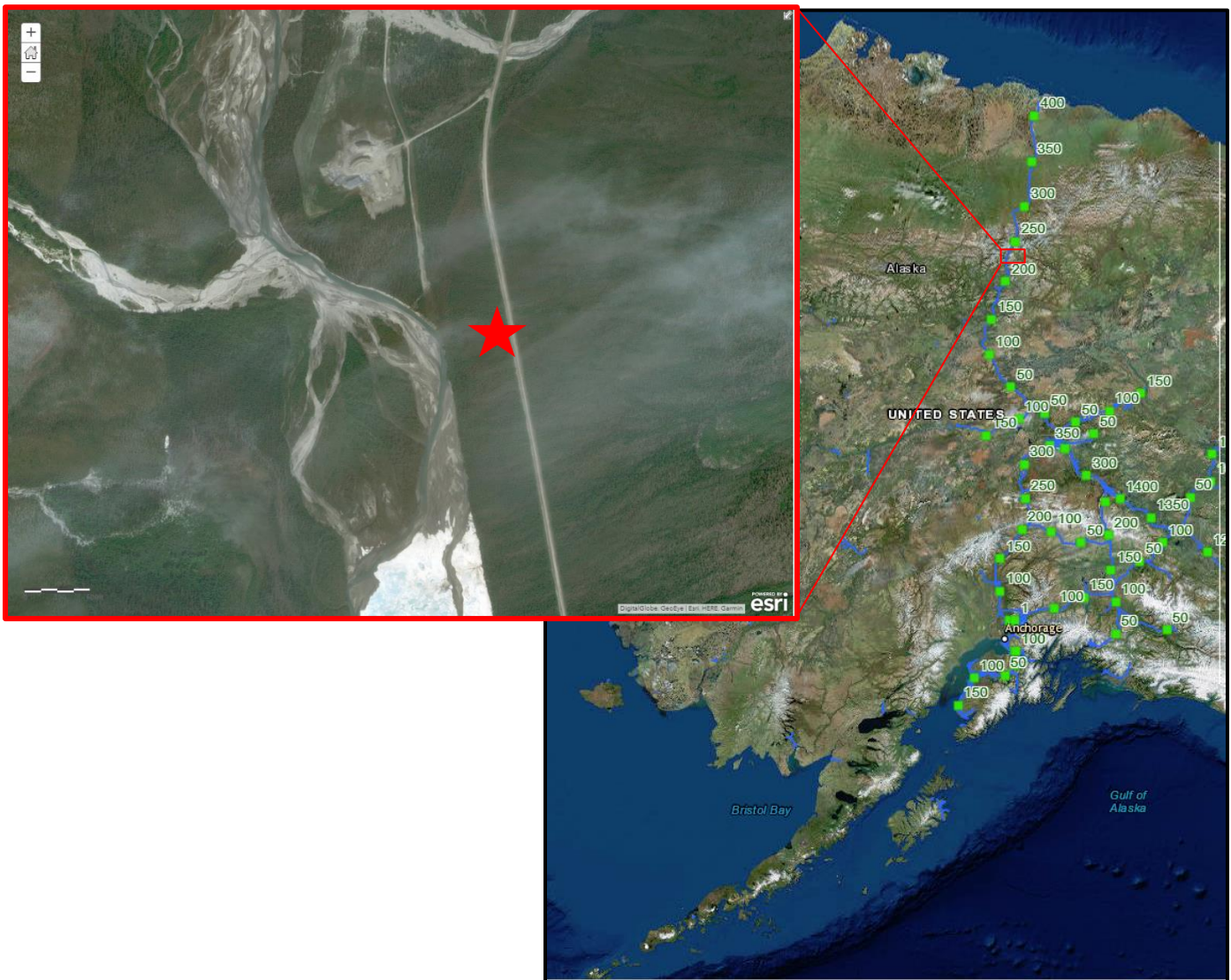
