Large¹ and small² ships must register with the State of Alaska. Fifty cruise ships registered in 2004: 31 large ships (only 29 visited³), 14 small ships, and five ferries. The number of registrants in 2003 was 52: 32 large ships, 15 small ships, and five ferries. In 2002 there were 44 registrants: 25 large ships, 14 small ships, and five ferries. The number of registrants in 2001 was 43: 24 large ships, 14 small ships, and five ferries.
