



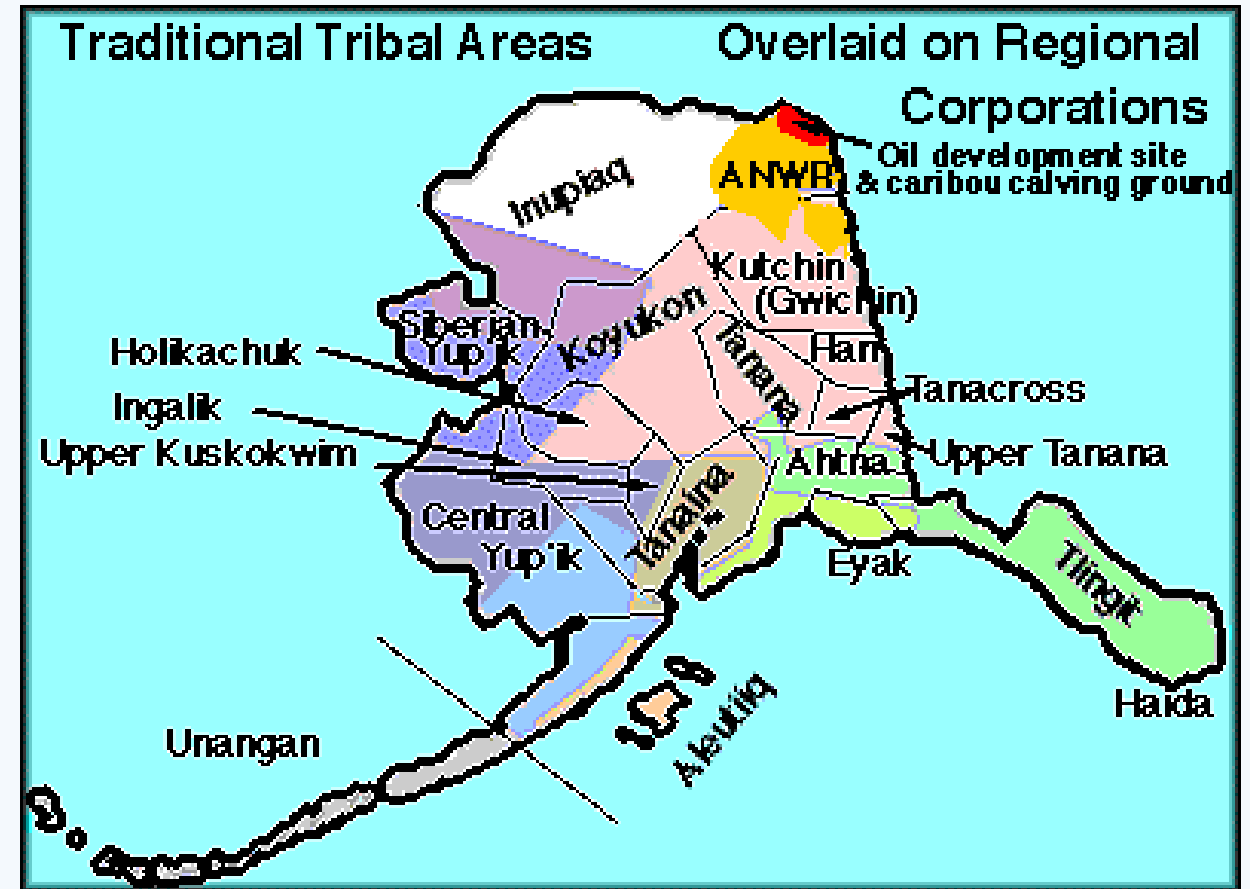

TRIBAL TAB TEAM

***Tribal TAB Team:** A team of professionals and experienced staff with knowledge of 128(a) Tribal Response Programs (TRPs) and Brownfields and related topics and issues.*

A team of “Partners” with tribal back grounds and experience that understand brownfields issues in a tribal context.

TAB Assistance to Tribes

- Free assistance to the Tribal Response Program (TRP) brownfields efforts
 - Coordinated through the tribal TRP-Brownfields coordinator or Environmental Program Manager.
- Requests for assistance accepted on a 'first come' basis
 - Depends on KSU TAB staff/funding availability
- No application process, just contact us

TAB Assistance May Include:

- Establishing a new TRP-Brownfields Program
- Assisting with Enhancing a TRP-Brownfields Program
- Assisting with the TRP 4 Program Elements
 - Help identifying and inventorying brownfields
 - Ensuring Response Actions are conducted and Adequate
 - Community outreach, input & workshops
 - Verification and certification of Response Actions
 - Assisting with the Public Record
 - Assisting with Institutional Controls

TAB assistance may also include:

- Reuse-redevelopment Mapping, Visioning & Planning
- Economic feasibility and sustainability analysis
- Help identify funding sources
- Review of EPA 104(k) competitive brownfield grant applications*

*(Tribal Corps in AK)

TAB assistance may also include:

- ❖ *Help with contracting, finding and evaluating environmental consultants*
- ❖ *Review of site project plans, QAPPs and technical reports*
- ❖ *Fact sheets and information for public outreach*
- ❖ *Other assistance, as needed and agreed upon*


