Plan to Cleanup Dry Cleaning Solvent Contamination at River Terrace RV Park

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) has prepared a Proposed Plan to cleanup dry cleaning solvent contamination remaining at the River Terrace Recreational Vehicle Park in Soldotna, Alaska. The Proposed Plan is available for public review and comment. The purpose of the Proposed Plan is to solicit public input regarding cleanup levels and the preferred cleanup methods. The public comment period ends on June 26, 2000. After all comments have been considered, ADEC will prepare a Record of Decision (ROD) that describes the final cleanup plan.

A formal public meeting will be held from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m, June 15th, 2000 at the Kenai Borough Chambers. ADEC will give a short presentation of the site and its proposed cleanup action, and will accept comments from the public regarding the Proposed Plan. Prior to the formal meeting, ADEC and its contractors will be available to the public to discuss specific site issues between 4:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. on June 15 at the Borough building. If you would like to meet and comment on the plan individually with ADEC, please call Mr. Sundet who will schedule an appointment at the ADEC Soldotna office on June 16.
