## **Proceedings**

Having reviewed the final South East Alaska Geographic Response Strategies (GRS) on the ADEC web-site, <a href="http://www.state.ak.us/dec/dspar/perp/grs/se/home.htm">http://www.state.ak.us/dec/dspar/perp/grs/se/home.htm</a> the Committee members:

- 1. Noted that only slight editorial changes had noted. These had been addressed.
- 2. Reviewed and approved changes to *Situk River SE09-03* (chart changes), *Point Couverdon SE07-03* (some change in tactics after a site visit), *and Mendenhall River SE07-01* (change in tactics after site test/boom deployment).
- 3. Noted that the size of the exclusion zone at the *Brothers* rookery should be clarified. This will be corrected by the contractors before publication.
- 4. Recommended that ADEC develop policies and procedures for GRS web updates perhaps once or twice a year on a schedule using standard forms. This would ensure the maps are kept current or updated as drills and site visits-of opportunities are made.
- Asked that a final CD (high resolution if possible) be distributed to Committee members. The contractors agreed to provide CD to the Committee and the SE AK SAWG.
- 6. **Recommended final approval** of the Southeast Alaska GRS.

Lewis Sharman Glacier Bay National Park and Preserve expressed his appreciation to ADEC for inviting and allowing NPS to participate in the work group process.
