


Oil Production, Transportation and Storage in Alaska



Major components of Alaska’s oil production, transportation and storage system. State-approved oil discharge prevention and contingency plans are required for regulated facilities and vessels. Plans are now in place for over 30 million barrels of crude and non-crude oil handled by Alaska’s storage and transportation system. The facilities designated as “non-regulated” are not required to have a state-approved oil discharge prevention and contingency plan.
