In 2010, The National Park Service requested that the 3 existing GRS within the Lake Clark National Park and Preserve be amended to protect additional natural resources and that an additional 4 sites be developed within the park.

The sites were visited and surveyed in August of 2010 and draft strategies were developed from the information and data collected. The Tactic Committee for the Central Cook Inlet met February 28, 2011 to review, offer edits and approve of the GRS' developed for the Lake Clark National Park and Preserve.

Existing Sites Amended:

CCI-09 – Gull Island
CCI-10 – Chinitna Bay
CCI-12 – Tuxedni River

New GRS Sites Developed:

CCI-23 – Shelter Creek
CCI-24 – Silver Salmon
CCI-25 – Johnson River
CCI-26 – Tuxedni Bay

The Committee reviewed each site and offered edits where needed. This input was captured and will be incorporated into the plans by Nuka Research & Planning Group.
