

Deploy free-oil recovery strike teams upwind and up current of Lazy Bay and Alitak Lagoon. Use aerial surveillance to locate incoming slicks.	Deploy multiple free-oil recovery strike teams as required to maximize interception of oil before it impacts the sensitive areas in Lazy Bay and Alitak Lagoon .	Vessel Platform	Via marine waters Chart 16591-1	Fish- intertidal spawning-herring (April-May) Birds-waterfowl concentration, seabird nesting Marine mammals-otters Habitat- marsh, sheltered rocky shoreline, gravel beaches Human uses-commercial fishing	Vessel master should have local knowledge.
