The Cook Inlet MFFP is currently being updated by the Cook Inlet Harbor Safety Committee (CIHSC) and will be incorporated in the new Cook Inlet Harbor Safety Plan, with an anticipated completion date of the summer of 2017. The purpose of the CIHSC is to provide a forum for identifying, assessing, planning, communicating, and implementing operational and environmental practices beyond statutory and regulatory requirements that promote safe, efficient, and environmentally sound maritime operations in the Cook Inlet.
