**SITUATION REPORT**

**INCIDENT NAME:** M/V Captain Jack Grounding                      **SITREP #:** 2 and Final

**SPILL NUMBER:** 04119916102    **LEDGER CODE:** 14954760

**TIME/DATE OF SPILL:** 10:00 A.M., June 9, 2004. The incident was immediately reported.

**TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT:** 3:00 P.M., June 14, 2004

**TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT:** This is the final report

**TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT:** The Coast Guard reported that the vessel had approximately 2,500 gallons of diesel fuel in addition to small quantities of miscellaneous oil and hazardous materials on board at the time of the grounding.

**LOCATION:** South of Edna Bay, Kosciusko Island, approximately 30 miles northeast of Craig, Alaska (Lat. 55 53.13 N. /133 42.6 W.)

**CAUSE OF INCIDENT:** The M/V Captain Jack, a 96.6 ft. passenger charter vessel, grounded after losing power.

**POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP):** Beverly Andreasen, North Pacific Excursions, Inc.

**RESPONSE ACTION:**

A salver from Naukati, Prince of Wales Island, responded to the spill site. The subcontractor (salver) and a crew of seven, successfully deployed containment boom around the grounded vessel on June 10<sup>th</sup>. The subcontractor used a landing craft with a fuel tank truck to remove approx. 2,200 gallons of diesel fuel. The salver has stated that they removed (10) 1-gallon containers of anti-freeze and (1) 5-gallon bucket of lube oil. The owner/operator advised DEC that they removed (22) 5-gallon buckets of lube oil. There was an undisclosed quantity of paint on board that burnt during the fire, and an undetermined amount of batteries left on board the vessel's engine room. The pollution response was completed on June 11<sup>th</sup>. Alaska Commercial Divers has reported that the owner/operator secured the vessel to a reef in order to perform necessary salvage work.

**SOURCE CONTROL:** The fuel and oils onboard have been removed.

**RESOURCES AFFECTED:** Marine waters have been affected but there are no reports of injured wildlife.

**FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Continue coordination with the Coast Guard on any salvage operations as they occur.  
Coordinate with Department of Natural Resources on vessel trespass on state land requirements.  
The Coast Guard will continue to investigate the grounding of the vessel and subsequent fire.

**WEATHER:** Forecasted cloudy, high around 60 degrees, winds West at 10-15 mph.
