

**UNIFIED COMMAND DECISION MEMO  
M/V SELENDANG AYU INCIDENT**

June 23, 2006

Subject: Completion of Response and Stand Down

The Unified Command has determined that response operations initiated as a result of the grounding and breakup of the M/V SELENDANG AYU are complete. Shoreline treatment has reached the lowest practicable level of contamination and remaining contamination does not pose a significant threat to public health or the environment.

Natural Resource Damage Assessment, the processing of claims, and other activities by federal, state, and responsible party organizations will continue. Ongoing communications among the organizations participating in the response and their constituents will also continue as needed.

Accordingly, the Unified Command will stand down effective with the close of business on Friday, 23 June, 2006.

The Unified Command wishes to express its thanks to all the organizations and individuals who participated in and supported the response. Particular thanks are sent to the shoreline workers whose careful, diligent work has reduced the presence of oil in the environment. The Unified Command is also grateful for the unfailing and effective support provided to the response by the government and people of the Port of Dutch Harbor and the City of Unalaska.
