**SITUATION REPORT**

**INCIDENT NAME:** F/V *Capt'N Andrew*

**SITREP #:** 3 and final

**SPILL NUMBER:** 11259906501

**TIME/DATE OF SPILL:** The 58-foot fishing vessel *Capt'N Andrew* went aground near Bold Cape/Table Rock, southeast of King Cove, at approximately 6:00 AM on March 6, 2011. ADEC was notified of the incident by the US Coast Guard at 6:40 AM on March 6, 2011.

**TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT:** 2:00 PM on March 11, 2011

**TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT:** This is the final report.

**TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED:** The owner of the *Capt' N Andrew* reported that approximately 2,000 gallons of diesel fuel and 450 gallons of lube and hydraulic oils were on board when the vessel grounded. In addition, the owner reported that 110,000-120,000 lbs of Pacific cod were in the fish holds of the vessel.

**LOCATION:** Approximately 4.5 miles southeast of King Cove, at the west side of the entrance to Belkofski Bay, at approximately 55° 01.512 N, 162° 13.459 W.

**CAUSE OF SPILL:** The cause of the incident is under investigation by the US Coast Guard.

**POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP):** Corey Wilson, vessel owner.

**RESPONSE ACTION:** On Thursday, March 10, 2011, salvors completed removal of all recoverable petroleum products from the vessel. They estimate that they removed approximately 1,200 gallons of fuel and oils from the vessel. A more precise volume will be determined when the fluids are offloaded in Dutch Harbor.

**SOURCE CONTROL:** No source control was implemented at the time of the grounding due to darkness.

**RESOURCES AFFECTED:** Shorelines in the area of the grounding consist of gravel beaches with intermixed rocky outcrops.

The area is designated as Northern sea otter and Steller sea lion critical habitat. Steller sea lions may be present on haulouts and in the areas of Belkofski Bay and the Pavlov islands. Waterfowl present may include stellers eiders, mergansers, harlequin ducks, and similar species. No impacts to wildlife have been reported.

No impacts to historic or cultural resources have been identified at this time.

Commercial fisheries operating in the area should not be affected and no closures have been initiated.

**FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:** Magone Marine Services Inc. will assist the owner in developing a wreck removal plan to be submitted to the US Coast Guard and the State of Alaska. The Alaska Department of Natural Resources will oversee removal of the vessel from state tidelands. The catch of Pacific cod will be disposed of during salvage operations.
