Trident/TDX St. Paul Warehouse Fire

TIME/DATE OF DISTRIBUTION: 1:00 p.m. on June 27, 2013

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Trident Seafood Corporation and the Tanadgusix (TDX) Native Corporation

INCIDENT LOCATION: The warehouse is located at 945 Hall Road, Anderson Building Warehouse, St. Paul Island, AK.

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: On the evening of February 9, 2012, a fire began at the Trident/TDX Anderson Building warehouse releasing hazardous materials.

HOW/WHEN SPILL WAS DISCOVERED: The spill was discovered during firefighting efforts on February 9, 2012 and reported to ADEC on February 10, 2012.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: Products stored at the warehouse included petroleum products, water treatment chemicals, and other hazardous materials (e.g., paint, roofing tar, and sealants).

CAUSE OF SPILL: The fire department conducted an investigation to determine the cause.

SOURCE CONTROL: The fire at the warehouse was extinguished and perimeter barriers were put in to place. Absorbent boom was placed in locations around the site. Once the investigation of the cause was completed a sand berm was erected to contain and prevent runoff of the contaminated water that had been used to fight the fire.

RESPONSE ACTION: G- Logics was contracted by Trident Seafoods to characterize the site and to provide work plans and reports in addition to leading the cleanup efforts in March 2012. Bering Sea Eccotech was also contracted by the Tanadgusix Native Corporation to perform demolition and cleanup actions for the site. A cleanup plan was submitted for approval to ADEC in July 2012. During the cleanup actions the identification, sampling and segregation of burn debris, liquids, contaminated soils, hazardous waste, non-hazardous waste, excavation, interim storage, transport and disposal of all hazardous and non-hazardous materials were completed. The inert waste materials were analyzed for contamination before disposal at the St. Paul landfill and further sampling of the hazardous materials collected at the site was conducted, and then submitted for lab analysis before transport and disposal to hazardous waste facilities located outside of the State of Alaska. Final cleanup was achieved in October 2012. An extensive final cleanup report was submitted for approval in March of 2013 and a letter of No further Action was issued by ADEC on May, 10, 2013.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: Petroleum and hazardous substances **impacted** surface and subsurface soils at the site. No wildlife was observed to be affected.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: **No further action required at this time**
