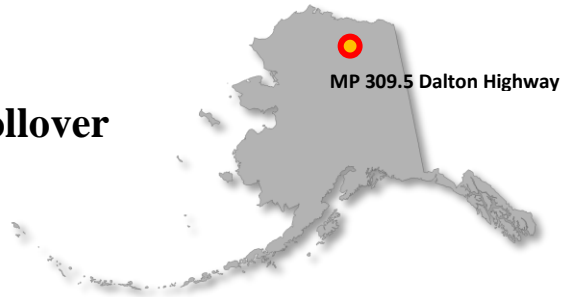

**Dalton Highway Truck Rollover
MP 309.5 Diesel Release**

TIME/DATE OF DISTRIBUTION: 5:00 p.m. on February 12, 2014

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Eggor Enterprises, Inc. (Eggor)

INCIDENT LOCATION: Dalton Highway Milepost 309.5

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: An Eggor driver went off the road while hauling fuel to Deadhorse from North Pole at 11:24 p.m. on February 11, 2014. The spill was reported to ADEC by Eggor through the after-hours reporting line at 7:33 a.m. February 12, 2014.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: The spilled product is diesel fuel. Based on a gauging of the tank containing the fuel that has been recovered, Eggor estimates that the spill volume is 2188.5 gallons.

CAUSE OF SPILL: Truck went off the road.

SOURCE CONTROL: Responders emptied the trailer and removed it from the accident site.

RESPONSE ACTION: Big State Logistics arrived on site shortly after the Eggor truck left the road. Big State Logistics was able to unload the remaining fuel from the trailer into an empty trailer. The fuel was then transported to Colville Inc. in Deadhorse. Colville Inc. is the owner of the fuel, and they provided to ADEC the volume measurement of recovered fuel from the trailer.

Eggor is working with Colville Inc. to mobilize response equipment and personnel. Initial assessment of the affected area is underway. No spilled fuel has been recovered at this time.

ADEC is mobilizing a responder to oversee the initial cleanup action.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: The area of impacted tundra and roadway is unknown at this time. Moose and caribou are commonly found in the region of the spill but no affects to wildlife have been reported.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: ADEC will continue to monitor the response actions and review plans being developed to clean up contaminated snow and soil.

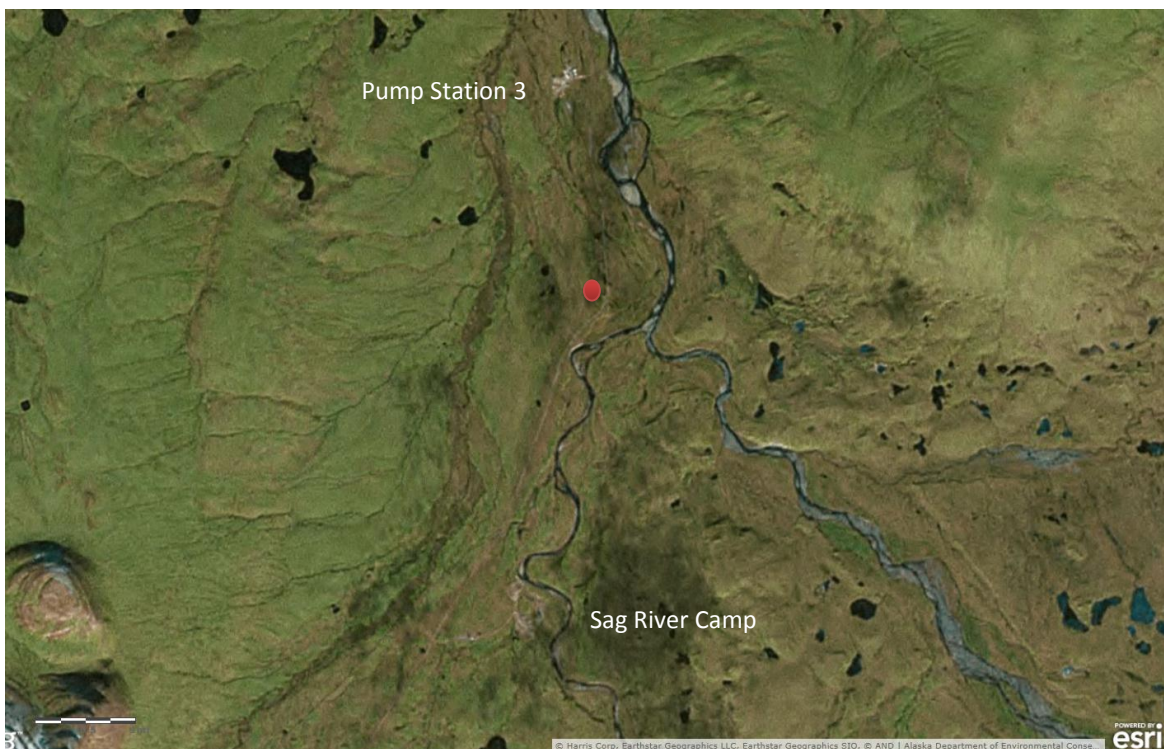
