POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): ConocoPhillips Alaska

INCIDENT LOCATION: Central Production Facility 3, Kuparuk Oil Field Alaska

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: November 15, 2017– 10:40 AM

HOW/WHEN SPILL WAS DISCOVERED AND REPORTED: Spill was reported to ADEC by ConocoPhillips Alaska at 11:55 AM on 11/15/17

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: An unknown volume of produced water. Produced water is a mixture of saline water and a small amount of crude oil.

CAUSE OF SPILL: Mechanical component at coupler located at the booster pump of the produced water tank failed.

SOURCE CONTROL: The booster pump has been isolated.

RESPONSE ACTION: Site safety has allowed access for response and recovery team to delineate, contain, and recover produced water. Liquid product will be recovered by suction and recycled or disposed. Solid products including frozen ice and gravel will be sent to grind and inject facility.

ConocoPhillips does not anticipate any significant impact to their production of crude oil.

RESOURCES AT RISK OR AFFECTED: Although the product stayed on pad the tundra plant community can be affected should the produced water get off the pad.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: Clean-up of released product will be conducted through an approved plan with analytically verified cleanup levels.

WEATHER: 14 F , wind gusts from E-NE at 22 MPH.
