Dear Stakeholder,

In the Spring of 2012, the Southeast Subarea Committee initiated the process to update the *Southeast Subarea Contingency Plan (SCP)*. The SCP contains guidelines and supporting information specific to the Southeast Alaska subarea, and supplements the *Alaska Federal/State Preparedness Plan for Response to Oil and Hazardous Substance Discharges/Releases* (aka Unified Plan).

The Southeast SCP, in conjunction with the Unified Plan, describes the strategy for a coordinated federal, state, local, tribal, and industry response to a discharge or substantial threat of discharge of oil or a release of a hazardous substance within the boundaries of the Southeast Alaska subarea. A map outlining the subarea is attached.

A new draft version of the plan is now available for public review. We request that you please review the new draft of the SCP and provide your input during the designated comment period, January 28 – March 11, 2013.

Significant changes to this plan include updates to every section of the plan. Two new additions (the Potential Places of Refuge (PPOR) Section and a part to address volunteers) have been developed and are included in this public review draft. Work is also underway to develop additional Geographic Response Strategies for the Southeast Subarea.
