Purpose of Meeting:

This is the first meeting of the workgroup tasked with developing Geographic Response Strategies (GRS) and Potential Places of Refuge (PPOR) that will be incorporated into Bristol Bay Subarea Contingency Plan (SCP). The primary purpose of the meeting is to acquaint the group with SCP and the process of developing the GRS & PPOR. The group will make preliminary selections of high priority sites for GRS development.

The goals for the workgroup during this meeting are to:

- provide information and background on the SCP and these project,
- inventory regional capabilities and risks,
- identify coastal areas at higher risk for oil spills within the Bristol Bay Subarea
- identify 25 priority sites for GRS development; other priority sites may also be identified for future GRS development
