## **Mechanical Placer Mining General Permit (AKG370000)**

### **Annual Report Requirements**

**Due Date:** no later than **January 31** for the previous calendar year

**If discharge to a receiving water occurs**, monitoring results shall be summarized each month and reported to DEC as part of the Annual Report (AR).

The Annual Report must include the following:

1. Permittee name;
2. APDES authorization number;
3. Receiving water name;
4. Monitoring results for settleable solids, turbidity, and arsenic;
5. Flow measurements and seepage estimates, the number of discharge events, and the duration of each discharge event for each day of the mining season;
6. Additional monitoring results;
7. Noncompliance reports; and
8. Permittee signature.

**If there is no mining activity during the year or no wastewater discharge to a receiving stream**, the permittee shall notify DEC on the Annual Report form.
