One Mile Creek

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

DFG Sportfish biologist Randy Ericksen called with concerns about water quality problems on One Mile Creek about a mile south of Haines. A residence next to the creek allows horses in the stream, has manure piled next to the stream bank and is letting trash and debris into the stream. This has been an ongoing problem. Potential violations of WQ Standards include Fecal Coliform, Residues (debris) and sediment from bank erosion. The City of Haines conducted a field investigation and determined that in addition to trash and manure polluting the stream, there were high counts of fecal coliform in roadside ditches that appear to be from failing septic systems.

Location: 1 mile south of town, Haines, Alaska

SUSPECTED VIOLATION(S)

WATER QUALITY: Violation of Water Quality Standards

SYNOPSIS:

Contacted Ben Kirkpatrick, Habitat Biologist, and will schedule an inspection of Haines sometime soon to investigate this and other problem sites.

Referred to City of Haines with technical support from Environmental Health (David Khan).

City cited resident for trash and manure pile as a nuisance, and if following up with an investigation of potential septic system problems.
