Description and Purpose:

The FishWatch Planning Team, an inter-jurisdictional partnership of non-profits, Tribes, and state and federal agencies created in 2001, and the CRWP will develop a strategy and work plan for conducting a coordinated habitat baseline assessment of the Copper River watershed and continue FishWatch baseline water quality monitoring.

Deliverables Include:

- 2003 FishWatch Annual Report with two seasons' water quality and human use data
- Meeting synopsis from March 2004 FishWatch Planning Team meetings with direction for “next steps” research on conducting watershed assessment for Copper River watershed.
