Pullen Creek and Skagway Harbor are priority waters in need of recovery, with metal contamination being a primary water quality concern. Historical studies show elevated levels of lead, zinc, cadmium, copper and mercury. This project, proposed by the Skagway Traditional Council, will collect scientific data on Pullen Creek to document contaminants, review and evaluate existing scientific data for Skagway Harbor to identify data gaps, and determine what actions are necessary for the recovery of both waters.
