
What's happened to date? What will happen at this meeting?

Over the last year, the community and their local and state partners have held seven work sessions to develop a draft water quality improvement action plan. A lot of progress has been made on the plan!

Right now, the public comment period is open for the Big Lake TMDL DRAFT document and will close on Tuesday, April 24th, 4:30PM. This document is part of the water quality recovery plan for Big Lake and incorporates the Action Plan developed during the community workshops. The TMDL establishes pollution limits for petroleum hydrocarbons. The Action Plan outlines how to achieve these limits.

During this meeting, the community and their partners will have the opportunity to understand:

- The purpose of a TMDL and how it relates to the community's action plan.
- The specifics of the Big Lake TMDL.
- How the TMDL will be implemented.
- How the community can provide comments on the TMDL.
