**Water Quality Antidegradation Workgroup
Meeting on February 2 and 3, 2012**

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) will convene an advisory Water Quality Antidegradation Workgroup to provide DEC with various perspectives and inform the department's development of draft implementation methods for the state's water quality antidegradation policy found at 18 AAC 70.015. The first meeting will be held on February 2 at 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., and on February 3, at 9 a.m. to noon. All meetings are open to the public and will take place in the DEC building at 555 Cordova Street in Anchorage. The Workgroup may meet as often as monthly for the next 6-12 months.
