**Proposed Project and Location:**

The Kenai Liquefied Natural Gas Facility is an existing natural gas processing plant which discharges industrial and domestic wastewater from Outfall 001, located at 60° 40' 41" North and 151° 23' 37" West, into the waters of Cook Inlet, Alaska. The discharge will occur at an average monthly rate of 170,000 gallons per day and will include proposed acute and chronic mixing zones for total residual chlorine, total aqueous hydrocarbons, ammonia, arsenic, copper, mercury, nickel, zinc and temperature.
