The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) has made a preliminary decision to approve United States Air Force (USAF) application for Air Quality Control Minor Permit AQ0318MSS04 and Operating Permit AQ0318TVP03 Revision 1 for the Clear Air Force Station (Clear AFS). ADEC proposes to issue a significant revision to the Title V operating permit using the integrated review procedures described in 18 AAC 50.326(c)(1).

**Location:** 200 A Street, Stop 1, Mile Post 284 on Parks Highway, Clear, AK 99704

**Activity:** USAF minor permit application is classified under 18 AAC 50.508(6) to revise coal monitoring strategy.

**Emissions:** The minor permit and revisions to the operating permit do not change emissions at Clear AFS.

**ADEC Preliminary Review:** Based on review of the application, ADEC drafted preliminary permit decisions for the projects under AS 46.14 and 18 AAC 50.

ADEC will consider all comments received and make any changes ADEC finds beneficial or necessary to assure compliance with 18 AAC 50 or State Law. ADEC will issue a final decision to issue or deny the permit after the close of the public comment period. Any person may request a public hearing and that hearing will be held if ADEC finds that good cause exists.
