The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) has made a preliminary decision to issue Air Quality Control Operating Permit AQ1527TVP01 for the Milne Point L-Pad under Alaska Statute 46.14 and regulation 18 AAC 50 after informal review under 18 AAC 15.185.

**Location:** Latitude: 70° 29' 48.1812" North; Longitude: 149° 38' 7.224" West

**Application:** As required by 18 AAC 50, Permittee applied for an operating permit for the Milne Point L-Pad. ADEC received the application on April 3, 2019. Hilcorp Alaska, LLC requested an informal review of the issued operating permit. ADEC received the request on January 3, 2024. This public notice is only for the conditions of the operating permit that were remanded for reconsideration (Conditions 28.5, 28.8, 28.11, and 29.14.c).

**Activity:** The stationary source supplies power to both the facility and the Milne Point Unit (MPU) grid which connects to the Central Facilities Pad (CFP).

**Emissions:** The potential annual emissions of regulated air contaminants at the facility are: 23 tons of particulate matter (PM-10), 233 tons of nitrogen oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>), 34 tons of sulfur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>), 240 tons of carbon monoxide (CO), and 98 tons of volatile organic compounds (VOC). The total potential emissions of regulated air contaminants is 628 tons per year.

**ADEC Preliminary Review:** Based on review of the request for informal review, ADEC drafted a preliminary permit decision for the stationary source under AS 46.14 and 18 AAC 50.

ADEC will consider all comments received and make any changes ADEC finds beneficial or necessary to assure compliance with 18 AAC 50 or state law. ADEC will issue a final decision to issue or deny the permit after the close of the public comment period. Any person may request a public hearing and that hearing will be held if ADEC finds that good cause exists.
