DOLLY VARDEN PLATFORM

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) has made a preliminary decision to approve Hilcorp Alaska, LLC's application for Air Quality Control Operating Permit AQ0060TVP05 for the Dolly Varden Platform, under Alaska Statutes 46.14 and regulation 18 AAC 50.

Application: Hilcorp applied for a renewal operating permit on October 18, 2024. This public notice is for the draft operating permit.

Activity: The Dolly Varden Platform is an off-shore oil and gas production platform. Oil and natural gas are processed through oil/gas separators on the platform. Product oil/natural gas is pumped through underwater pipelines to the Granite Point Tank Farm. The natural gas is also used as fuel on platform or it is flared.

Emissions: The potential annual emissions of regulated air pollutants at the stationary source will not exceed: 338.89 tons of Nitrogen Oxides, 227.41 tons of Carbon Monoxide, 17.79 tons of Particulate Matter, 387.26 tons of Sulfur Dioxide, 194.10 tons of Volatile Organic Compounds, and 2.05 tons of Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP), with highest individual HAP (formaldehyde) estimated at 1.01 tons. The potential annual emissions for Greenhouse Gases are estimated at 161,770.90 tons of carbon dioxide equivalent emissions. The total annual potential emissions of regulated air pollutants, other than greenhouse gases, are 1,165.44 tons.

ADEC Preliminary Review: Based on review of the application, ADEC drafted a preliminary permit decision for the Dolly Varden Platform under AS 46.14 and 18 AAC 50.

ADEC will consider all comments received and make any changes ADEC finds beneficial or necessary to assure compliance with 18 AAC 50 or state law. ADEC will issue a final decision to

issue or deny the permit after the close of the public comment period. Any person may request a public hearing and that hearing will be held if ADEC finds that good cause exists.
